

EMBEDDING AUDIO

This tutorial walks you through embedding **Audio & Video**. Audio files must be MP3. Video files must be MP4 with h.264 encoding.

Step One

Go to Window > Folio Overlays to open the folio overlays panel.

Step Two

To attach audio that plays automatically on a page, simply select File > Place. Look for the audio file named AudioSample and click Open. Click anywhere on the page to drop the audio in.

Step Three

Click the preview button to test your audio.
Select Preview on Desktop.



Step Four

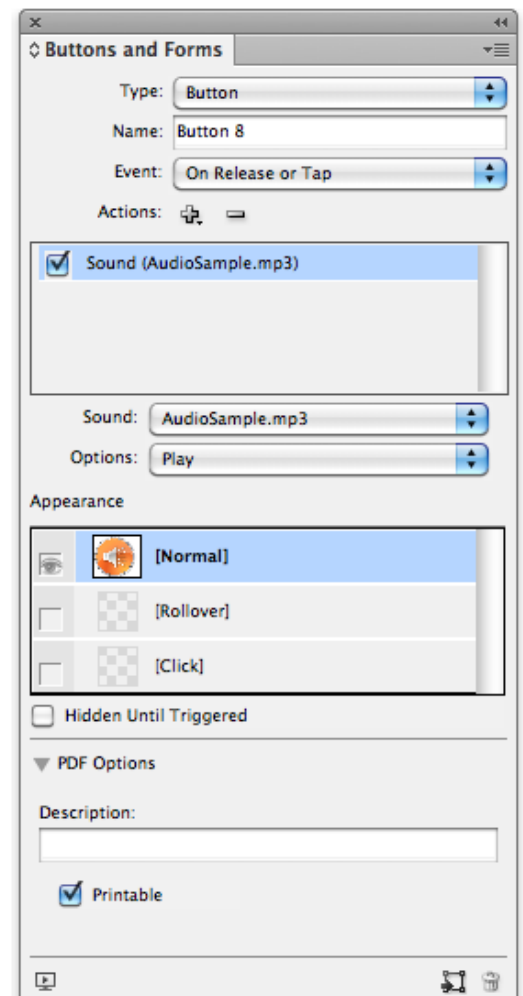
To attach audio to an image, you need to create a button and attach the audio to it. Go to File > Place and find the Audiolcon image created for this tutorial. Select it and click Open.

Step Five

Turn the audio icon into a button using your Buttons & Forms panel. Add a Sound action to the button. Select AudioSample.mp3 in the Sound drop down menu.

Step Six

Click the preview button to test your audio.
Select Preview on Desktop.



EMBEDDING VIDEO

This tutorial walks you through embedding **Audio & Video**. Audio files must be MP3. Video files must be MP4 with h.264 encoding.

Step One

Go to Window > Folio Overlays to open the folio overlays panel.



Step Two

To embed video onto a page, select File > Place. Look for the video file named BatmamClip.mp4 and click Open. Click anywhere on the page to drop the video in.

Step Three

Go to Window > Interactive > Media. The Media panel allows you to set specifications for how your video will play, as

well as what kind of controller you would like to use. In the Media panel, select SkinOverAll from the Controller drop down.

Step Four

Click the preview button to test your video. Select Preview on Desktop.
